HONORING OUR PAST

1951: A survey conducted by the Alabama Baptist Convention cited the need for nine new churches in Etowah County, AL. Clubview area was a recommended site.

1958: The mission committee of the Etowah Baptist Association (EBA) identified an eight-acre tract on Rainbow Drive, purchased with resources from the Alabama Baptist Executive Board, EBA and First Baptist Church of Gadsden.

August 23, 1959: The organizational and constitutional service was held on the property under a borrowed National Guard Armory tent. The church began that day with 87 people and soon had 147 charter members.

February 28, 1960: The church broke ground for its first building using an old turn plow pulled by members and guided by the pastor. The chapel was completed and the first service was held on September 11, 1960.

April 11, 1965: A second building was constructed for the growing ministries associated with the church.

December 12, 1971: A new sanctuary was dedicated to the Lord along with a tower holding forth a cross for passers-by.

September 30, 1990: The Family Life Center was constructed with the intention of enhanced ministry and community outreach.

February 23, 1997: A three-story education building was completed, providing 44 classrooms for all ages.

November 21, 2004: A remarkable \$600K offering was collected in one Sunday, making the church debt free.

September 10, 2006: Worship services were moved to the FLC for greater seating capacity.

EMBRACING OUR FUTURE

MeadowBrook remains centered on honoring Christ and serving people through missions and ministry. Our facilities are tools that help us accomplish our purpose. To continue and to increase our ministry, the church has elected to raise 8 million dollars to construct a worship center, additional classrooms and connection spaces for gatherings. Placing the new facility amid our other structures connects all of the buildings under roof.

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE FACILITY:

- Beautiful worship auditorium that will enhance our worship and proclamation, which will also be conducive for Christ-centered weddings, funerals, and services
- 7 additional classrooms, giving us more opportunity to disciple people with Bible truths
- Connective gathering places, including a coffee café, to meet with people for personal conversation and reflection
- Manor Street parking and building entry, easing traffic on Brookhaven and providing senior adult and special needs parking near the building

- Large covered entries for safer drop-off and pick up for children, women and the elderly
- New playground location, providing children a safe environment to play
- New look and approach to MeadowBrook's campus for people traveling south on Rainbow Drive
- A grand corridor connecting all of the church's buildings will eliminate walking outdoors in inclement weather
